Pursuant to the provisions of the New York Freedom of Information Law, Article 6 of the Public Officers Law, and associated case-law, I hereby request the following public records:

Copies of any and all communications between the New York City Mayor's Office and any agency or department relating to the development of the proposed list of properties to be subject to taxation, pursuant to New York Tax Law Article 30-C or Chapter 32 of Title 11 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, as added by Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2026, Part HH.
2. Copies of any and all communications between the New York City Mayor's Office, any agency or department and the New York State's Governor's Office or any agencies of New York State relating to the development of the proposed list of properties to be subject to taxation, pursuant to New York Tax Law Article 30-C or Chapter 32 of Title 11 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, as added by Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2026, Part HH; and
3. Copies of any and all records (including drafts and non-final lists) relating to the development of the proposed list of properties to be subject to taxation, pursuant to New York Tax Law Article 30-C or Chapter 32 of Title 11 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, as added by Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2026, Part HH.

I am requesting that these records be delivered to me electronically at jason@nygop.org, if all of the requested records cannot be provided via email, please advise me of the cost for reproducing portions of the records that cannot be sent via email. As you know, the Freedom of Information Law requires that an agency respond to a request within five business days or receipt of a request. Therefore, I would appreciate a response as soon as possible and look forward to hearing from you shortly.

If for any reason any portion of my request is denied, please inform me of the reasons for the denial in and provide the name, address, and email address of the person or body to whom to an appeal should be directed.
